A Note to Parents

Please ensure that any child in your care understands the legal and safety needs before and during the use of these vehicles. The misuse of these vehicles can lead to fatalities and serious injuries.

The Right Vehicles

Ensure the vehicle is appropriate to the rider.

Find the vehicles that are correct for the age, size and strength of the rider.

The Right Equipment

It is recommended that all riders wear protective equipment:

Helmet (mandatory), boots, body armour and gloves

The Right Training

The Right Environment

These vehicles are designed for off-road use and in a controlled environment.

Know the Law - Obey the Rules of the Road

*Certain scramblers and quads do not comply with vehicle standards and are therefore limited to off-road use only. It is illegal to use these vehicles in a public area if vehicle standard requirements are not met. **On Road Use:** Both the user and owner require a valid certificate of insurance. A vehicle must have a registered number plate, insurance, road tax, lights and reflectors. **Off-Road Use:** Riders must be minimum 16 years of age and hold an A1 category driving licence.
