### **Items discussed:**

#### **1. Path around green.**

The group refer to the green area at the back of the Moyville Estate that is being used by various residents for different activities. The residents are looking for a circular path to be placed around the park. The group state that a motion has been submitted supporting the request. The group request information on the next step of the process and ask if money for the project has been included in this year's budget or has the deadline been missed. The group have also applied for Environmental Grants and ask if the status of these applications can be checked.

#### **2. Footpath repairs.**
