



Creative Ireland: Cruinniú na nÓg 2019 Open Call

South Dublin Arts Office is pleased to announce an open call for artists, creative practitioners, arts organisations, and creative/cultural communities to submit applications for Cruinniú na nÓg 2019 as part of the South Dublin Creative Ireland Programme. This open call is for activities, performances, readings, workshops, interactive art installations, etc to take place on Saturday 15th June 2019.

Cruinniú na nÓg celebrates and encourages children and young people's participation in culture and creativity through performance, coding, theatre, art and music workshops, readings, screenings, special events and much more. Events are free, local and activity-based. It's a day for 'doing', 'making' and 'creating'!

This year we are looking for *all* types of artists to present work in the form of activities, performances, developmental workshops or projects for young people aged 0-18. These activities will take place within the community of South Dublin County. They can happen in community centres, public spaces, schools, libraries, and venues. These events can be one off to happen on the 15th June or be project based with the final outcome demonstrated on the 15th June. Activities are inclusive of all art forms and creative forms including but not limited to visual art, music, dance, drama, storytelling, puppetry, circus, street art, performance, coding, design, readings, poetry, crafting, etc. We are looking for innovative activities that foster creativity and engage a diverse audience.

Awards will be given from a minimum of €500 up to a maximum of €10,000.

Timeline

Applications open 22 January 2019

Deadline for Submission 1 March 2019

Notification of award: 12 March 2019



Selection Criteria

- a) The extent to which the proposed event/project maximises children, youth and community engagement
- b) The extent to which the proposed event/ project is ambitious, innovative, and fosters creativity in children and young people
- c) The potential scope of the event/project and anticipated target audience, including culturally diverse participants and audience
- d) The cost of the proposed event/project
- e) The feasibility of completing the project by 15th June 2019

Conditions

- Payment of the award will be made in April 2019.
- All projects must be completed by 15th June 2019.
- The project must have a public event or showing in South Dublin County.
- Funding may be used to purchase materials / to engage an artist in the to create new work / to fund an exhibition / or performance of new work.
- Funding may not be used for competitions (entry or travel to)
- Funding provided by Creative Ireland South Dublin must be acknowledged in all publicity material associated with the work. Logos are available from the South Dublin County Council Arts Office.
- Successful applicants will be asked to provide a short written report describing their experiences and the impact of the event/events.
- South Dublin County Council reserves the right to publicise the awarding of the fund. Successful applicants may be asked to be available for promotional material.
- The selection panel reserves the right not to grant an award if the standard of applications does not satisfy the criteria of the award in full.
- Only proposals with completed applications and the required documents will be considered. Proposals and applications will be held onto for a year.
