# Local History Talk: The Archaeological excavations at De La Salle Ballyfermot With Antoine Giacometti

We are very excited to welcome Antoine to Clondalkin Library and hear what was revealed in these local excavations.



Dublin City Council has undertaken an archaeological excavation of the remains of a large enclosure at the former De La Salle monastery and primary school site in Ballyfermot.

Human remains were idetified at the medieval site and evidence indicates there was a settlement during the second half of the first millennium (AD 500 to AD 1,000).


