Friday February 14th, 10.30am





Chess Club


Wednesdays, 6.00pm - 7.30pm

Jonathan Swift's Drapier Letters were a series of seven pamphlets written in 1724 and 1725 against English government plans to introduce a new coinage into Ireland. Written under the pseudonym M.B. Drapier, Swift used satire to cause widespread resistance, and the plan was withdrawn. Drapier's letters are celebrated as a masterpiece of political writing.


