**ROAD WORKS SPEED LIMIT ORDER - ROADS ACT 2004, SECTION 10**

**GRANGE CASTLE ROAD (R136)**

To facilitate works on behalf of ESB Networks, South Dublin County Council proposes to introduce a speed limit of 60km/h on the Grange Castle Road (R136) from its junction with Adamstown Avenue/Thomas Omer Way to a point 500m south of its junction with the Nangor Road (R134), from Monday 25<sup>th</sup> February 2019 to Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2019.


