

ROADS ACT 1993, SECTION 75

PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PEARSE BROTHER'S PARK/GLENMORE PARK, RATHFARNHAM, DUBLIN 16

To facilitate Cleary Doyle Ltd. on behalf of South Dublin County Council to deal with storm water out fall from the new social housing development in Rathfarnham by installing connections to the estate infrastructure for a storm water drainage system. South Dublin County Council propose to temporarily close a section of the following roads from **Monday 16th March 2026 to Friday the 19th June 2026**. The works will be undertaken over **four phases (4)** as follows. Note phase 2 will not require a road closure.

Phase 1:

- Road Name:** Junction of Glenmore Park and Pearse Brother's Park adjacent to house No. 25, Pearse Brother's Park.
- Dates:** Monday 16th March 2026 to Friday 10th April 2026.
- Time of Closure:** 24hrs daily.
- Detour Route:** via Pearse Brother's Park Eastward from R113.

Phase 2: (not a closure):

- Road Name:** Single lane usage at Glenmore Park and Pearse Brother's Park Junction.
- Dates:** Friday 10th April 2026 to Monday 4th May 2026.
- Time of Closure:** 24hrs daily, STOP/GO system.

Phase 3:

- Road Name:** Between Houses No. 25 – No. 29 Pearse Brother's Park.
- Dates:** Monday 4th May 2026 to Friday 22nd May 2026.
- Time of Closure:** 24hrs daily.
- Detour Route:** via Glenmore Park and Pearse Brother's Park.

Phase 4:

- Road Name:** Between Houses No. 29 – No. 33 Pearse Brother's Park.
- Dates:** Friday 22nd May 2026 to Friday 19th June 2026.
- Time of Closure:** 24hrs daily.
- Detour Route:** via Glenmore Park and Pearse Brother's Park.
- Local access to be maintained at all times.
 - 24 hr emergency access to be maintained.
